GREEN SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (GSDP)

In line with the Skill India Mission of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has launched a Green Skill Development Programme (GSDP) under which different courses/training programmes are being offered to skill enthusiasts, who are 18 years and above, as Master Trainers (MTs)/ Specialists. You can choose to be skilled in any of the following fields:

FREE Training will be provided in eminent institutes that are associated with MoEF&CC. No TA/DA will be admissible for attending the written test/interview and joining of the training programme. As Master Trainer you will be engaged in skilling youth in diverse environmental fields, thus creating India's 'Green Skilled' workforce. The courses / training programmes will be as per the National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF) of NSDA*, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship. Certificates would be awarded to successful candidates on completion of the courses.

Certificate Courses under GSDP for Master Trainers (MTs) / Specialists to commence in July, 2018 (Duration of courses ranges from 80 hours to 560 hours approx). Last date for submission of application 31st May, 2018
